Uniform and Winter Weather

Thank you so much for all your support with uniform this term so far. I just want to take this opportunity to remind you that all trousers should be **tailored trousers**, not tight-fitting. We will contact all parents whose children may need support in meeting this part of the uniform policy to work together for a solution ready for the start of the new term.

As the winter sets in, we know that our site at Dinnington is really exposed, and students must move outside to get to lessons. We experienced the first wet weather last week and we wanted to share some tips about **improving student resilience**. We found our younger year groups really struggled and wanted to go home because they were wet!

- We encourage students to walk to school in wellies or trainers and change into their school shoes when they arrive. Consider the shoes worn by your child throughout the day, pump style shoes can get very wet!
- Bring a spare pair of socks.
- Wear a coat; we had lots of students just come to school with only an umbrella. We have some spare coats and waterproof coats in school that students can borrow too, so please encourage your child to do this if they don't bring a coat to school.
- Access in school to radiators is limited, but we will always try to help students use these to dry their wet items!
